At an anti-nuke rally in Tokyo, a man approached our group and bought a badge. As he paid, he casually said, "I' m from Fukushima". It often happens that those who want our badges are themselves from Fukushima. They give us money first and then express their feelings about wearing the badge.

We immediately gave him his money back, handing the special Fukushima badges for him and his family. But he still insisted on making a donation. So we said, "one of the reasons why we are at this rally is to give the badges to people from Fukushima. We want to help them to express themselves by wearing the badge. Please give the badges to others. We don' t want money".

With his eyes filling with tears, the man exclaimed, "Fukushima land was always in me - now my homeland is gone!"
